Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.135 dated 15.12.2020, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police district Batala, district Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross version. There is a delay of 15 days in lodging the FIR wherein it is alleged that the petitioner had pushed the complainant who fell on the bricks and suffered injuries on his head. He also contends that two sons of the petitioner had also received injuries in the occurrence and one of them is in custody.

This Court, by the order dated 10.02.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Kamaljeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
