The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.249 dated 27.11.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (later on added 326 IPC) at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

On 30.01.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner on right side muscle of the complainant does not fall under the mischief of Section 326 of Indian Penal Code. The injury on the right wrist of the complainant falls under ambit of Section 326 of IPC and that injury is attributed to Jaspreet Singh and Balwinder Singh. Criminal petitions of Dharam Pal Singh, Ajay Hehar @ Jhony and Naresh Chaudhary are pending in the High Court along with interim relief.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 13.02.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.2575 of 2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.01.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Atma Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 30.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
