Learned State counsel points out therefrom that the petitioners, even petitioner no.1, has now attained majority, and they continue to reside together and therefore, as regards the FIR registered at the instance of the father of petitioner no.1, i.e. respondent no.4 herein, a cancellation report has been prepared by the police

That being so, though there is some problem with the network connection of learned counsel for the petitioners, I would see no reason to keep this petition pending which is consequently disposed of, with a direction to respondents no.1 to 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners continues to remain protected, as and when any complaint is received in that regard.
