The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.200 dated 17.05.2019 under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC and Section 3 of Haryana Protection of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Faridabad, Haryana.

In response to the notice issued to the State, a status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, had been filed in which it has *inter alia* been stated that during the course of investigation, the petitioner had voluntarily joined the investigation and that he was not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above stand taken by the State, on 05.03.2021, while adjourning the case for today, this Court had directed that on appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court, he be released on ad interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel submits that in terms of the afore interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on ad interim bail.

In the light of the above referred affidavit filed by the State as also because that the petitioner has shown his bonafide by appearing before the trial Court, the interim order of this Court dated 05.03.2021 is made absolute.
