The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 0045, dated 15.12.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women-1, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 30th January, 2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Gurbhajan Singh, states that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, recovery of some gold ornaments have not yet been effected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently disputed the said fact by urging that the petitioner is not in possession of any gold ornaments as alleged, as the same had been taken away by the complainant-wife when she had left her matrimonial home.

Heard.

Be that as it may, the demand and entrustment of gold ornaments are all disputed questions of fact, which would be considered by the trial Court during trial.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the present petition stands allowed and interim order dated 30th January, 2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
