The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.616 dated 23.08.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station HTM, Hisar.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had helped candidates in solving PTI examination. The petitioner is in custody for over 6 months and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaivir, states that the petitioner is a Constable in Delhi Police. As per record of the calls made by him, his location was found near the examination centre and there is other incriminating material which implicates him in the case. He further states that challan has been filed and no witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 6 months, he is not involved in any other criminal case, the COVID-

19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
