The matter has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.150 dated 18.09.2020 registered under Sections 399, 402
of IPC and Section 25 (Act No. 54) of Arms Act, 1959, at Police
Station Khanna City-2, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that
pursuant to the order dated 10.02.2021 passed by this Court,
petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Vijay
Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the
custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at
this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.02.2021 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
