ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 365 dated 06.10.2020, under Section 147, 149, 323, 379-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order on 10.02.2021:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.365 dated 06.10.2020 registered under Sections 147, 323, 379-B and 506 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner did not commit the alleged offences. Even as per the version given in the FIR, the petitioner was armed with wooden stick. No specific injury/role has been attributed to the petitioner and vague and general allegations of beating of the complainant have been made against him. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, Addl. A.G., Haryana has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Mr. J.P. Sharma, Advocate has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant and undertakes to file his power of attorney in the Registry.

Learned State Counsel and learned Counsel for the complainant seek time to file reply.

Adjourned to 29.04.2021.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail by the arresting officer/investigating officer on furnishing of bail bonds by him to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. failing which he shall not be entitled to the protection of interim anticipatory bail allowed to him.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Narender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 contends that in view of serious allegations against the petitioner, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
