Through this criminal writ petition, the petitioners are praying for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from private respondent Nos.4 to 7 as they have solemnized marriage on 03.02.2021 against their wishes.

On 10.02.2021, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondents No.4 to 7, as they have entered into marriage on 3.2.2021 against the wishes of private respondents.

Notice of motion to the respondents.

Mr. Manreet Singh Nagra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General, Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the State prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

Adjourned to 26.2.2021.”

Today, no one has appeared in this case on behalf of the petitioners, however, status report by way of affidavit of Kulwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural, District Gurdaspur alongwith respective statements of the petitioners (Annexures R-1/T and R-2/T) and respondent Nos.4 and 5 (Annexures R-3/T and R-4/T) has been filed by the State, wherein the petitioners have stated that they do not apprehend any danger from anyone. Respondent Nos.4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.1) have also stated that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, petition is rendered infructuous.
