Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to send the case of the petitioner to the State Level Committee for the grant of premature release to him in view of the latest policy dated 12.04.2002 (Annexure P-7).

Copy of reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Jhajjar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the case of the petitioner for premature release has been pending since 13.04.2021 before respondent No.2-Director General of Prisons, Haryana.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition. However, he prays that respondent No.2 be directed to decide the case of the petitioner for premature release, within a stipulated period.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, respondent No.2-Director General of Prisons, Haryana, is directed to decide the case of the petitioner for premature release within a period of three months after receiving the copy of this order, in accordance with law.
