Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.70 dated 20.05.2020 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 10.02.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ranjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide dated 10.02.2021 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
