Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who was working as Principal in the Government School, is claiming the benefit of promotional increment from the date she was promoted to the post of Principal keeping in view the Rule 12 of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 and also the Grade Pay of ₹6,400/- w.e.f. 01.01.2016 by stepping up her pay as the persons juniors to her were getting the said grade pay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the grievance, which has been raised in the present petition, the petitioner has approached the respondents by serving a legal notice (Annexure P-10) dated 05.10.2020, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-10) dated 05.10.2020 by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to prayer of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being raised by the petitioner in the present petition as well as in the legal notice (Annexure P-10) dated 05.10.2020, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice submitted by the petitioner Annexure P-10 dated 05.10.2020 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same be also released to her within a period of next three months.
