By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.282, dated 26.12.2020, having been registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provision of Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Pursuant to the order dated 10.02.2021, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and as per the instructions of learned State counsel from ASI Kulvir Singh, his custodial interrogation is not required presently at this stage.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is

disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
