The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondent No.3 and 4, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 10.2.2021, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Learned State counsel has filed the statements of the petitioners wherein they got recorded their respective statements and stated that they do not apprehend any danger.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that in view of the statements of petitioners, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
