1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P-1 dated 11.01.2021 in CWP No.20714 of 2020.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 11.01.2021, CWP No.20714 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the competent Authority to decide the petitioner's representations/applications Annexure P-4 and P-6 within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and till decision on the said representation, not to insist upon the petitioner to carry out election duty.
4. Mr. Pawan Longia, DAG, Haryana has placed on record copy of order dated 12.2.2021 accepting the claim of the petitioner for voluntary retirement as well as sanctioning the Earned Leave. The said order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who

states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position as noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
