The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

While issuing notice of motion by this Court vide order dated 11.02.2021 respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka was also directed to look into the grievances of the petitioner and take appropriate action for protection of her life and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstance.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on instructions by respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, statement of the petitioner was recorded and now the petitioner does not have any apprehension of immediate danger to her life and liberty from respondents No.4 to 6 and the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition which may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh petition in case of apprehension of danger to her life and liberty in future.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
