The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing respondents No.2 and 5 to get detenue-Pooja released from the illegal custody of respondents No.6 and 7.

This Court had vide order dated 08.02.2021, directed respondents No.1 to 5 to file Status report before the next date of hearing.

In compliance of the above said order, status report by way of affidavit of Dr. Ravinder Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Sonapat has been filed on behalf of respondents No.3 and 5 in the Registry which is taken on record.

In the status report, it has been mentioned that enquiry was made and statement of Pooja was recorded. In her statement Pooja stated that she got introduced with petitioner Manjeet on Tik-Tok app and she remained in talking terms with him for about 7/8 months, but

presently she has no talk with him nor she wants to do so. She does not want to perform marriage with Manjeet, but he is pressurizing her to perform marriage with her and he has filed false complaint against her father and cousin Kawaljit for pressurizing them. She further stated that she has not been illegally confined by any person and she has the entire liberty to go outside the house and her family members or any relative has not been pressurizing her to perform marriage as per their wishes, rather, she has been given the liberty to perform marriage as per her wishes.

Since detenue Pooja has not been illegally detained by anyone including respondents No.6 and 7, no further action is required to be taken on the present Habeas Corpus petition which is disposed of accordingly.
