By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.226, dated 07.11.2020, having been registered at Police Station Chheratta, Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 420/120-B of the IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals Act, 2014.

The petitioner having been admitted to interim bail pursuant to an order of this court (co-ordinate bench) dated 11.02.2021, on the last date of hearing the ACP (West), Amritsar City, was directed to file a short affidavit as to whether the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required or not.

Today, an affidavit of the said officer has been filed in court by learned State counsel, dated 02.12.2021, which is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the said affidavit the petitioner having joined investigation and having co-operated with the investigating agency, her custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed with the order dated 11.02.2021 made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
