Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4, for releasing the petitioner on parole for a period of two weeks, enabling him to attend the marriage of his sister.

While poring the head-note of the petition, it is axiomatic that marriage of sister of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 10.02.2021, whereas in the Panchayatnama (Annexure P-2), it is mentioned as 15.02.2021.

There are contradictory dates mentioned in the head-note of the petition and that in the panchayatnama (Annexure P-2) qua the solemnization of marriage of sister of the petitioner.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
