1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of needful having been done, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab states that non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional but due to administrative exigencies on account of circumstances prevailing on account of coronavirus pandemic and in view of needful having been done the contempt petition be disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
