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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition for issuance of directions to the respondents for fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 12 dated 21.1.2020, under Section 346 IPC, registered at Police Station Badagudha.

As per the pleadings, the investigation is not proceeding further and not even a single person has been arrested or interrogated by the police.

Learned counsel for the State, appearing on advance notice, on instructions from ASI-Shamsher Singh submits that the matter is being investigated and polygraph tests of four accused, namely, Jagtar Singh, Darshan Singh, Kulwinder Singh and Kuldeep Singh have been conducted

on 4.2.2021 and the report is still awaited. She refutes the allegation that the matter is not being looked into.

In view of the fact that the matter is being investigated and even polygraph tests have been conducted, no case is made out for interference by this Court for issuing direction. No ground is made out for transferring the investigation to some other State Vigilance Bureau or Central Bureau of Investigation.

The petition is dismissed.
