Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 11.01.2021 passed by the trial, vide which the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. as additional accused to face trial in case FIR No. 004 dated 05.01.2018, registered under Sections 148, 302, 307, 323, 324, 325, 326, 506(II) read with Section 149 of the IPC at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has instructions to say that the petitioners, who were declared innocent by the police during investigation and now have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C. vide impugned order, do not press the petition on merits, provided that they are granted concession of regular bail on surrendering before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no serious objection to the aforesaid prayer.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioners made at bar, the present petition qua challenge to aforesaid impugned order on merits is dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioners are granted liberty for 30 days from today to surrender before the trial Court and in case they do so, the trial Court shall release them on regular bail, on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

It will be subject to a condition that petitioners will not challenge the summoning order and will face the trial in accordance with law.
