The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0324 dated 08.10.2020 under Sections 147/148/323/325/341/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Gadpuri, Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 11.02.2021 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.
