Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.89 dated 29.12.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 24.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, the same remains unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and affirms that the mediation remains unsuccessful as the petitioner has not intentionally honoured the compromise arrived at and he is not keen to settle the dispute.

Interim protection was granted vide order dated 24.08.2021, the outstanding disputes are to be evaluated by the trial Court on the basis of the evidence to be led before it by the parties.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 24.08.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
