Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.374 dated 30.11.2020 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar.

On 23.02.2021 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case; the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case; even if the case of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, the petitioner is attributed only one injury on the ring finger of the left hand which has been wrongly classified as a grievous injury and that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr.H.S. Sitta, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 17.05.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.374, dated 30.11.2020, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined the investigation; has cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above and the statement made by learned State counsel that the petitioner's custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 23.02.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
