AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

The present petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Jalandhar to present the status report in FIR No. 269 dated 24.11.2020, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar. Further prayer is that the petitioner has an apprehension that the police will exonerate the accused without giving opportunity to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the enquiry before registration of the FIR, the petitioner had submitted the relevant documents and the investigation is not proceeding further.

Learned counsel for the State, appearing on advance notice, on

instructions from ASI-Gurvinder Singh submits that the accused in the FIR have moved an application before the Senior Superintendent of Police. On the said application, enquiry has been marked to Superintendent of Police. The submission is that the matter is still under investigation.

Considering the fact that the FIR is dated 24.11.2020, not even two months have passed and the petitioner has approached this Court on mere apprehension that the police may exonerate the accused. It appears that the present petition has been moved only as a tactic for influencing the investigation.

No case is made out for interference in the matter by this Court.

The petition is dismissed.
