Present contempt petition has been filed alleging non-compliance of order dated 24.11.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 9650 of 2020

Learned State counsel states that in compliance of the order dated 24.11.2020, a speaking order dated 11.02.2021 has been passed, wherein it is stated that the representation of the petitioner has been looked into and decided accordingly. It is further stated that no substance has been found in the representation made by the petitioner. In the light of the order passed, it cannot be said that the order of this Court has not been complied with.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

Needless to add that, it would be open to the petitioner to take recourse to any appropriate remedy in accordance with law, if still aggrieved.
