Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of dishonor of a cheque issued by respondent No.5, namely, Sham Sunder Chadda, the petitioner instituted a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against respondent No.5. However, respondent No.5 as a counter-blast made a complaint to the police that the petitioner had misused some blank signed documents of respondent No.5. It has been submitted that the petitioner had made a representation dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-9) to the police highlighting all the facts and requested the police to conduct a fair investigation into the matter, but to no avail.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Rajeev Anand, learned APP, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and accepts notice.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the

averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law expeditiously.

Respondent No.2 is directed to give a personal hearing to the petitioner before finally deciding the representation in case the same has not already been decided so far.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-9) be sent to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
