At the very outset, learned State counsel has informed that as on date 25 PWs out of cited 27 PWs already stand examined and that all efforts would be made by the prosecution to conclude its evidence at the earliest.

Having regard to the aforestated position, this Court does not deem it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage particularly keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had earlier been declared a proclaimed offender after having been released on bail by this Court.

The petition, as such, is dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to take all such steps, as may be possible during the present circumstances of spread of pandemic, for expediting the trial.
