The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 04.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 whereby petitioner has been transferred from the office of respondent No.3 to office of respondent No.2. Without taking into consideration that he is suffering from heart ailment and needs medical treatment under the supervision of his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is working on the post of Sub Inspector in the office of respondent No.3 and he has been transferred to the office of Transport Commissioner, Haryana Chandigarh-respondent No.2 vide order dated 04.02.2021 (Annexure P-3). He further submits that the petitioner is suffering from heart ailment and he is basically the resident of Rohtak. It is very difficult for him to travel from Chandigarh to Rohtak as it is not medically advisable for him to stay alone and he needs family care keeping in view his medical condition. Alongwith this petition, he has also placed on record medical record (Annexure P-4).

A representation dated 08.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) has also been sent to the Transport Commissioner, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 to cancel his transfer.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A copy of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of this case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to decide representation dated 08.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously.
