The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that he has applied for an online transfer in accordance with the Policy to Regulate Transfers and Postings of Doctors [Health Department] (Annexure P-2), according to which doctors can make an online request for transfer during the month of January each year giving three preferred places of posting.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that last year the petitioner had applied for transfer, however, the same was rejected. Thereafter, he had approached this Court by way of CWP No.2795 of 2020 which was dismissed vide order dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure P-5). Now as per the guidelines laid down in the Policy (Annexure P-2), the mother of the petitioner has once again applied for an online transfer vide undated letter, Annexure P-6, sent by speed post to respondent no.1 on 22.10.2021.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. A.G.,

Haryana has joined the session through video conferencing and accepts

notice on behalf of the respondents. He has pointed out that the petitioner had earlier also approached this Court by way of CWP No.2795 of 2020. However, the same was dismissed vide order dated 03.02.2020. The learned State Counsel has further submitted that as per the guidelines (Annexure P-2) the doctors can apply online for transfer by giving three preferred places of posting in the month of January every year. However, no such application has been filed by the petitioner and without even applying as per the guidelines sought to be relied upon by the petitioner, he has approached this Court with the same prayer which was made in the earlier petition which was dismissed by a speaking order.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner in the present case had earlier approached this Court by filing CWP No.2795 of 2020 which was dismissed vide order dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure P-5). The same prayer is being reiterated in the present petition. Further, as per the guidelines appended with the petition as Annexure P-2, the petitioner has the option of applying for a transfer online during the month of January each year giving three preferred places of posting. However, no such application has admittedly been made by the petitioner. In view thereof, the present petition is dismissed.
