Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.154 dated 27.08.2019 under Sections 353, 186, 332, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 03.02.2020: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M-49512-2019 has already been filed before this Court seeking quashing of the present FIR on the basis of compromise, in

which notice of motion has been issued and now the case is fixed for 26.03.2020.

Mr. Veeraj Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and acknowledge the factum of compromise arrived at between the parties...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
