Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major, petitioner No.1–Gurdeep Kaur, aged 18 years and petitioner No.2–Sandeep Singh, aged 23 years and have got married on 09.02.2021, against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as private respondents. It has been further submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the marital life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. She, on

instructions from SI Jagjeet Singh, has apprised this Court that FIR No.22 dated 22.01.2021 registered under Section 363 and 366-A of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Safidon, District Jind already stands registered against petitioner No.2.

In view of aforementioned facts and circumstances, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
