The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner illegally and not to call the petitioner in the Police Station again and again without any reason or rhyme at the behest of respondents No.10 to 12.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdit Singh, submits that the petitioner is in fact a man of criminal antecedents in as much as three cases are registered against him i.e. 1) FIR No.27 dated 04.02.2021 under Sections 66 of the Information Technology Act; 2) FIR No.146 dated 20.08.2020 under Sections 294, 354, 451, 506 and 34 of the IPC, 1860; 3) FIR No.102 dated 25.08.2018 under Sections 294 and 506 of the IPC, 1860 all registered at Police Station Tibba, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has submitted that it is precisely for this reason on account of the registration of the aforementioned FIRs which are still under investigation, the petitioner is being called to the Police Station by the investigating agency. She has, therefore, vehemently controverted the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being illegally called to the Police Station time and again without any rhyme or reason.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
