This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.357 dated 04.11.2019 under Section 7-A of Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act (Section 420 IPC and Sections 3, 7 (1) & (ii) of Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Bhal Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 12.03.2020, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.
