The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.23 dated 27.01.2021 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (for short, the Excise Act) registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Ludhiana.

A bare perusal of paragraph No.11 of the present petition shows that the petitioner is involved in two other cases under the Excise Act. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to admit the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
