The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0002 dated 16.01.2021 under Sections 363/366-A IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

As per allegations, daughter of the complainant was enticed away by Gurpreet Singh, Sandeep Singh, petitioner and one Kamaldeep Singh. All other accused except the petitioner have been arrested.

The victim has been recovered and in her statement

under Section 164 Cr.P.C., role of the petitioner has been shown.

No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Court and apply for regular bail. In the event of surrendering and applying for regular bail, the same shall be considered by the trial Court on merits at the earliest.
