Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.108 dated 04.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 186, 353, 148, 149 IPC and Section 61(1) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Vide order dated 12.02.2021 interim bail was granted to the petitioner subject to the terms and conditions as shown in the order itself.

Co-accused namely Sukhdeep Singh @ Happy and Sukhdeep Singh @ Deepa Ghali could not get any order in their petitions filed under Sections 438 Cr.P.C. as their petitions were

withdrawn as having become infructuous vide order dated 29.09.2020 passed in CRM-M No.24032 of 2020 and CRM-M No.23957 of 2020 respectively.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Mangat Ram submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 12.02.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
