The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 & 5, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 12.02.2021, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Status report by way of an affidavit by Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Panipat on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed by learned State counsel alongwith the affidavits of the respondents No. 4 & 5 (Annexure R-1 & R-2), who stated that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact

and submits that in view of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
