The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.249 dated 04.07.2020 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Batala, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is the husband of the deceased sister of the complainant. It is urged that, allegations under Section 306 IPC would not be made out against the petitioner as per the medical report itself. It is urged that as per the Viscera report dated 22.09.2020, the cause of death was due to failure of functions of heart and lungs. He further contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Narjeet Singh, would submit that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the confirmation of interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner by contending that there are serious allegations made out in the FIR which would constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the viscera report wherein it has been opined that the cause of the death of complainant's sister was due to failure of functioning of heart and lungs. .

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 13.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
