The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeks directions for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioner of the period from 01.12.2019 to 30.09.2020 and to release the salary of the abovesaid period, the re-employment period.

Counsel for the respondents submits that the salary for the re-employment has been paid @ Rs.36,636/- per month, in view of the directions issued on 15.03.2021, for the re-employment period on D.C. Rates on outsourcing basis of the petitioner as Executive Engineer.

Mr. Malik, is aggrieved against the payment on the ground that the remuneration made is of the lower post.

If that is so, the petitioner is given liberty to challenge the said action by filing a fresh writ petition on the said ground. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, for the claim which has been sought.
