This the third petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.196, dated 16.09.2019 under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Divison No.7, District Ludhiana.

Vide order 18.02.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer to the grant of interim bail to the petitioner, as she is suffering from various serious ailments. Pursuant thereto medical report of the petitioner was called for vide order dated 26.02.2021.

In compliance of order dated 26.02.2021, medical health status report by way of an affidavit of Iqbal Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail Hoshiarpur, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. The Registry is directed to place the same at an appropriate place.

As per the affidavit filed by the State along with the report of the board of doctors of Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur, the petitioner aged 70 years is a patient of K/C/O type 2 diabetes mellitus, hypertension and

coronary Artery disease, in addition to having degenerative changes in the Lumber spine which are age related. It has also been reported that in her ECG S/o Left axis deviation with ischemic changes in the antero lateral wall is seen which is suggestive of ischemic heart disease for which she would require Cardiologist opinion.

The learned counsel has thus prayed in view of the petitioner's medical condition a compassionate view be taken and she be extended the concession of interim regular bail so that she can get herself medically examined and treated from a private medical speciality hospital.

On a query put to the learned State counsel as to whether the petitioner is involved in any other NDPS case, he has replied in the negative.

Heard.

In the wake of the medical report of the petitioner placed before this Court, she is directed to be released on interim bail for 06 weeks to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner is directed to surrender back at Central Jail Hoshiarpur on 26.04.2021 before 5:00 PM positively. It is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

The petition stands disposed off.
