The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner HC Parbjot Singh and 15 others have filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to release the amount of CPF contribution along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based upon the pleadings submits that the petitioners were initially appointed as Special Police Officers. Learned counsel then makes reference to para 10 of the petition to submit that in spite the petitioners have made contributions towards CPF from the date of regularization till date as mentioned in the chart (P1), the same amount has not been invested by the respondents.

In this regard, learned submits that for same/similar grievance, the petitioners have submitted a legal notice dated 16.12.2020.

Notice of motion.

On the asking, Mr. DS Sukarchakia, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide claim of the petitioners as contained in the legal notice (P6) by passing a speaking order within 6 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
