The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.170 dated 25.12.2019 under Sections 452, 354-B, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Tara Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and challan has been presented.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 03.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
