ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, working as a clerk in the District Courts, Kaithal, sought permission to appear in SAS Part-I (OB) examination to be conducted by Department of Finance, Government of Haryana, and learned District Judge, Kaithal, vide impugned order dated 28.1.2021, has declined the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner strenuously argues that while similarly situated employee working in District Courts, Karnal has been accorded the permission, subject of course to an undertaking that in case he gets selected in the SAS examination he shall have to resign from his current post, but the petitioner has been discriminated against. Learned counsel submits that he has instructions to state that the petitioner is also ready and willing to give similar undertaking.

When learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4, appearing on an advance copy of the petition, was confronted with the question as to how different yardsticks are being adopted in different District Courts of the same

State, he expresses his unawareness qua the order passed by the learned District Judge, Karnal, granting any such permission.

Be that as it may, learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4 to verify the order passed by the learned District Judge, Karnal. In case, it is so as contended aforesaid, the petitioner shall then also be given the permission to appear in SAS examination, subject to the same undertaking as mentioned in the order passed by the learned District Judge, Karnal.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
