The petitioner against whom his daughter-in-law Harjot Kaur had moved a complaint, which is being inquired into by the DSP, (NRI & Women), Phase-VII, SAS Nagar (Mohali), has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to get the matter enquired from any district outside Mohali.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground for transferring the inquiry to any district outside Mohali. However, since the petitioner is aged about 59 years and is a resident of Amritsar, it is directed that the petitioner be not repeatedly called to Mohali. In case, the statement of the petitioner has already been recorded during the course of inquiry proceedings, then he may be associated with any further inquiry by way of video conferencing, if possible.

Since it is a matter, which has apparently arisen out of some kind of matrimonial discord, efforts be made to probe the possibility of some amicable settlement and for which purpose, the parties may be referred to the Mediation Centre in District Court at Mohali or at Fatehgarh Sahib, as the complainant i.e. the petitioner's daughter-in-law is stated to be hailing from District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
