Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.1292 dated 23.10.2018 registered under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Jagadhri, District Yamunanagar.

Vide order dated 01.02.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties. He has placed on record the agreement/memorandum of understanding dated 06.09.2021, which is taken on record as mark 'A'.

Learned State counsel and learned senior counsel for the

complainant do not dispute the factum of the compromise.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.02.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
