Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents to conduct a fair investigation in the complaint made by him. He has sought a further direction to respondent No. 3 to release his four wheeler immediately.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sukhpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, wherein it is stated that there was a dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents with regard to lease of 22 acres of land and the farming equipment had been purchased by respondent No. 4. It is further stated that the petitioner had filed a civil suit with regard to the same cause of action. A copy of the civil suit has also been attached.

Heard.

It is manifest that the petitioner has already filed a civil suit for

the release of the tractor and thereafter has preferred the instant petition. A copy of the civil suit has been annexed as Annexure P2. Therefore, I do not find any ground to exercise the jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, especially when the matter is pending adjudication before the trial Court.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed being wholly misconceived.
