Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.237 dated 11.12.2020, under Sections 354-A, 354D of Indian Penal Code and Section 67A of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station City-I, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 15.02.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.02.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. However, it is submitted that the recovery of mobile phone from the petitioner is not yet effected and the petitioner has made a statement during investigation that he lost it one year back.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.02.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
