(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

A complaint made by Kamaljeet Kaur has been received through e-mail and under the orders of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jaswant Singh has been treated as Criminal Writ Petition and ordered to be listed on judicial side.

In her complaint Kamaljeet Kaur made prayer for finding her husband Satwinder Singh, who was missing with effect from 04.02.2021.

In compliance with order dated 12.02.2021, status report by way of affidavit of Harvinder Singh Cheema, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed through e-mail print out of which is taken on record.

In the status report, it has been mentioned that on 05.02.2021 recovery of opium weighing 1 Kg. 500 grams was made

from possession of Satwinder Singh husband of the petitioner regarding which FIR No.13 dated 05.02.2021 was registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 in Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga in which case the husband of the petitioner was arrested and is in judicial custody.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that Baljinder Singh brother of husband of the petitioner was informed about the arrest.

In the course of hearing, Baljinder Singh brother of Satwinder Singh was contacted who stated that he was informed about the arrest of Satwinder Singh on 05.02.2021.

In view of the above, no further proceedings are required to be taken on the present habeas corpus petition which is disposed of accordingly.
